## Horse Chestnut Tree (Stocks Tree) on Village Green

The Horse Chestnut tree has been inspected and unfortunately, is showing signs of fungal and bacterial infection and significant rot in the stem. The Highways Tree Officer has recommended removal of the tree and this will be carried out shortly by Oxfordshire County Highways. The area of land is actually Highways land and so they are responsible for the removal.
